



Pool Hours & Rules

May & September	Saturday & Sunday	10 a.m. – 8 p.m.
June, July & August	Monday – Sunday	10 a.m. – 9 p.m.

A lifeguard will be on duty during the above hours. ONLY ADULTS may swim without a lifeguard.

1. All members and guests must sign in. **No exceptions.** Guest fees will apply- (\$5) each guest may come twice a month up to 6 times per calendar year, regardless of host.
2. Obey the lifeguards and all pool rules. Children not cooperating with lifeguards will be asked to leave the premises. Children under the age of nine (**9**) will **NOT** be allowed to swim without direct adult supervision in the immediate gated pool area. Immediate pool area does **NOT** include any of the tennis courts or other club premises that are outside of gated pool area.
3. Bathing suits may not be worn outside the gated pool area and grill window. Cover-ups and shoes must be worn outside the pool areas at all times.
4. Glass containers and ice chests will not be permitted on Club premises at any time.
5. Absolutely **NO** food or drinks will be permitted in the locker rooms. No gum chewing or eating while swimming.
6. The locker rooms are not a play area. Children should take care of their business and return to the pool area. The lifeguards will strictly enforce this rule.
7. Walk at all times while on pool deck, porches and sidewalks.
8. Diving will be permitted in the deep end of the pool only. Swimming under the diving boards is strictly prohibited.
9. Beach balls and soft spongy balls will be the only balls permitted in the pool. No tennis balls will be allowed.
10. Horseplay will not be permitted anywhere in the pool area. This area includes the deck, pool, the patio area, and the locker rooms.
11. Only one person will be permitted on the diving board at a time. Only one bounce will be permitted on the diving board.
12. The lap lane is for those specifically swimming laps, not for play or casual wading. Do not pull, hang, or hold onto the lane rope.

13. Parents will be responsible for their children and their guests while they are on Club premises and will be liable for any damage done on Club property.
14. In the event of bad weather, the pool will close at the discretion of the lifeguards and/or the management, under the American Red Cross recommended procedures.
15. The Club assumes no responsibility for injury or death in connection with the swimming pool facility. The Club will also not be responsible for any valuables or clothes left unlocked or unattended in the locker rooms, tennis courts, or pool area.
